Admin

- Work continues on the potential improvement of Caldwell rail line using the \$4.5 million appropriated by the General Assembly. The current rail operator and lease holder is unwilling to address provisions of the lease agreement that must be amended prior to beginning the project. It appears the only path forward involves buying out the rail operator/lease holder. The funds appropriated by the General Assembly cannot be used for the buyout. Passenger rail service is not an option due to the low population density along the corridor, making it ineligible for federal grant funding. Staff is working with local governments to determine the next steps.

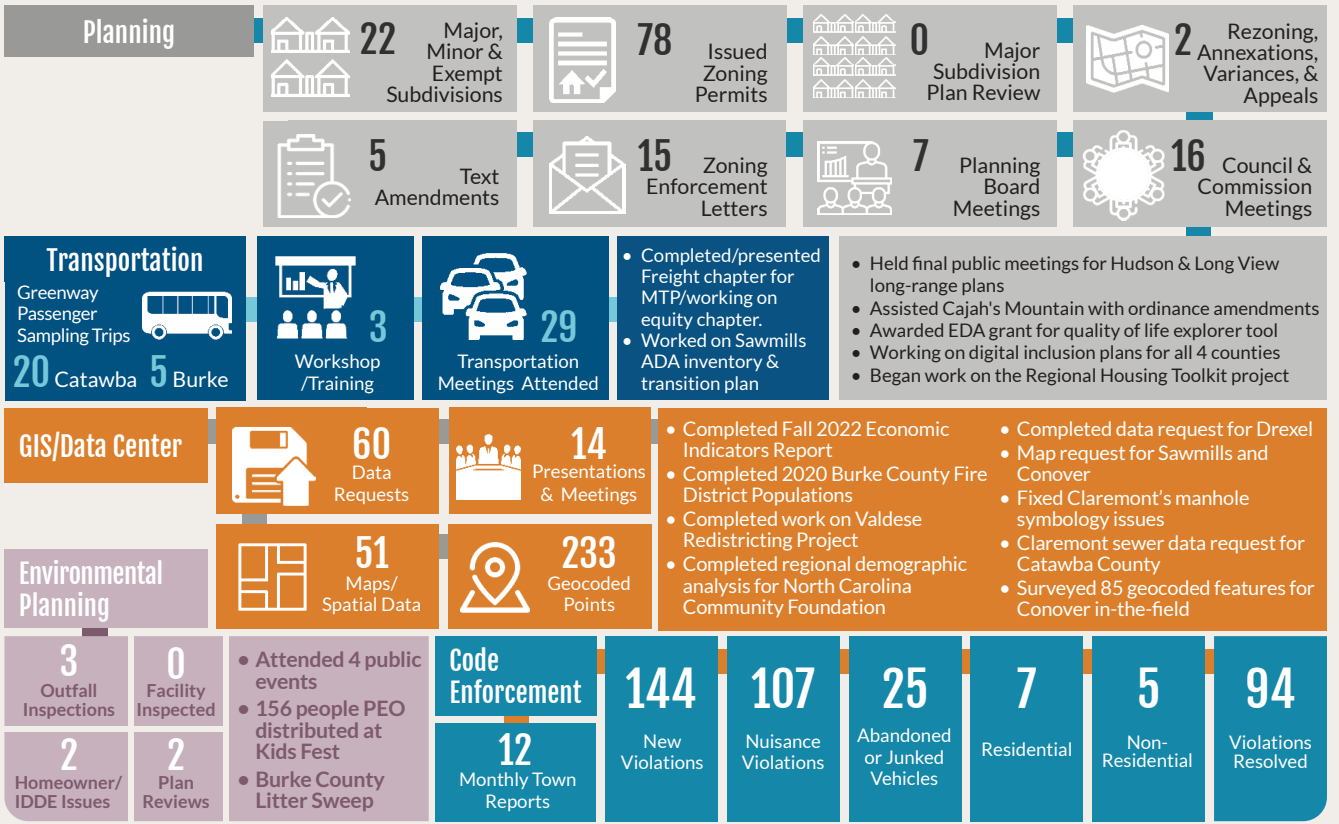

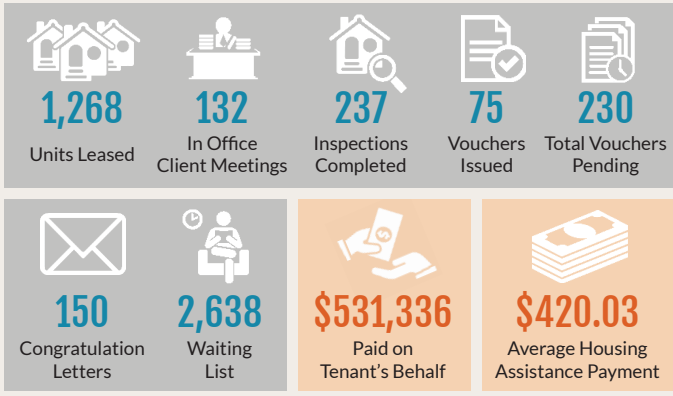

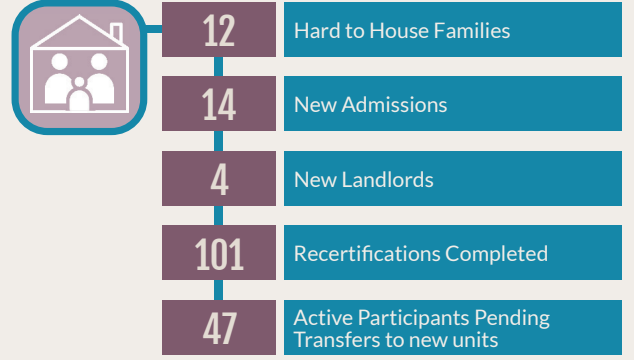
