Essential Single Family Rehab (ESFR)

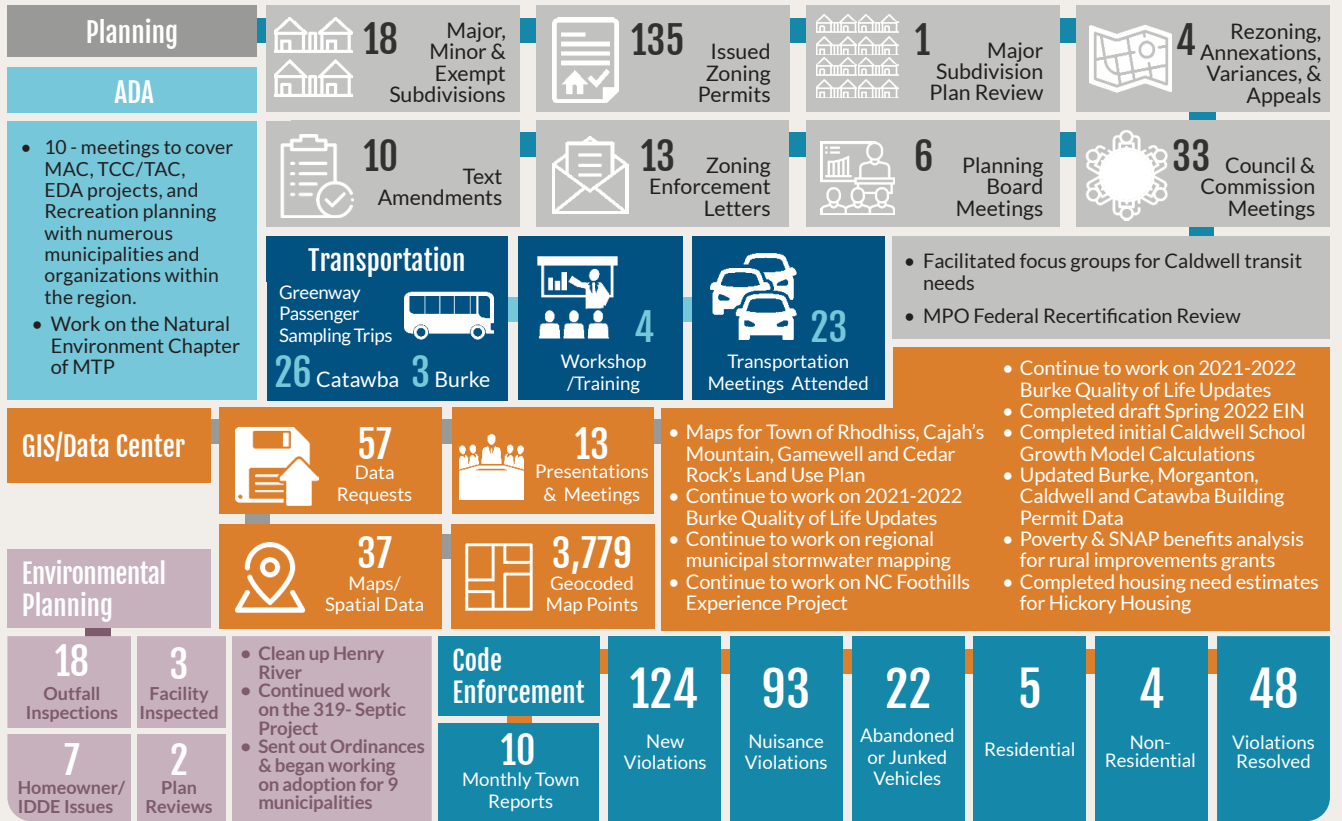
- Alexander and Catawba County was awarded 2022 ESFR funds to complete 4 houses in each county over a 3 year period.

- Burke URP 1 completed, 8 out to bid

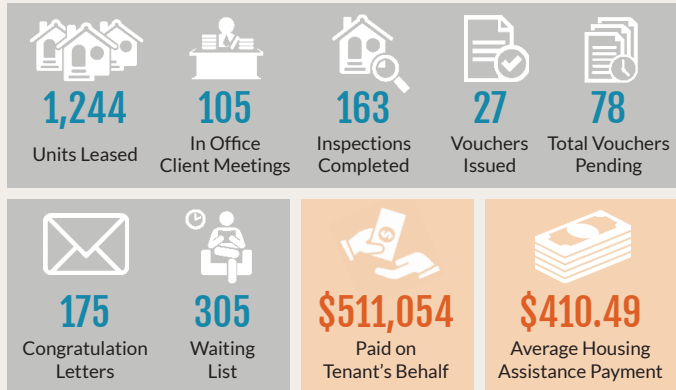

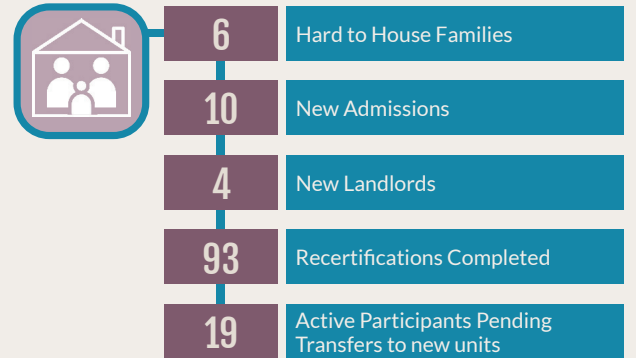

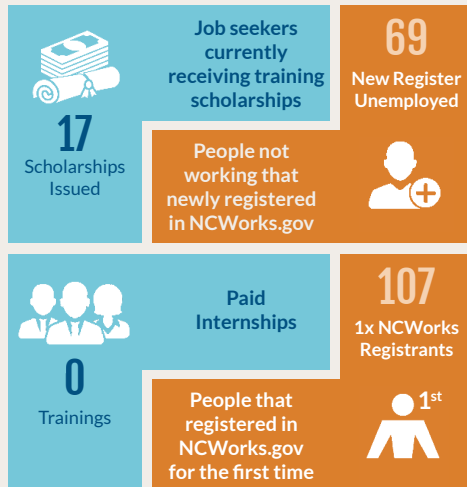
