- CED staff are in the process of completing, assisting, and submitting numerous grant applications.
- To leverage unused ARPA funds, a coordinated regional request for \$5.7 million in public safety equipment was submitted to our regional legislators on behalf of 22 law enforcement and emergency services agencies.
- Caldwell County was successfully awarded a Golden Leaf Site Program Due Diligence Grant for \$50,000. Funding will be utilized to complete due diligence on the Foothills Regional Airport.
- CED staff closed out a \$253,494 NC Commerce Building Reuse Grant on behalf of Burke County and Marves Industries. The company renovated a vacant manufacturing building and created 23 new, full-time jobs with an average wage of \$43,529.
- CED staff is currently working on applications that include NC Great Trails and CDBG.
- Community and Economic Development staff are currently administering 85 grants for local governments in our region.

- 1,510 hours dedicated to intake procedures


