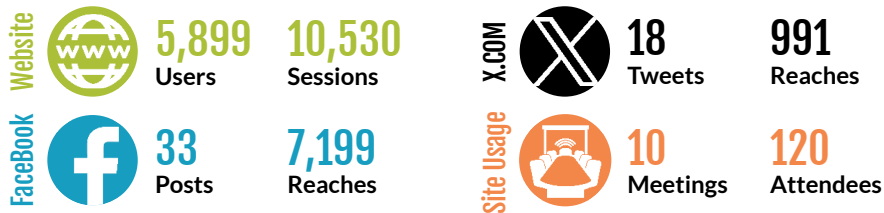




ADMINISTRATION

COMMUNITY & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT



- CED staff successfully assisted the Town of Valdese in securing a \$2,236,775 grant for a waterline replacement project in the Berrytown Community. This project will upgrade outdated infrastructure, benefiting approximately 81 homes, including 51 low-to-moderate income households.
- CED staff submitted three (3) ARC applications for Western Piedmont Community College, VEDIC, and the City of Lenoir and is currently working on applications that include NC Great Trails, CDBG, and Rural Downtown Economic Development Grants.

• Community and Economic Development staff are currently administering 85 grants for local governments in our region.

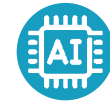
