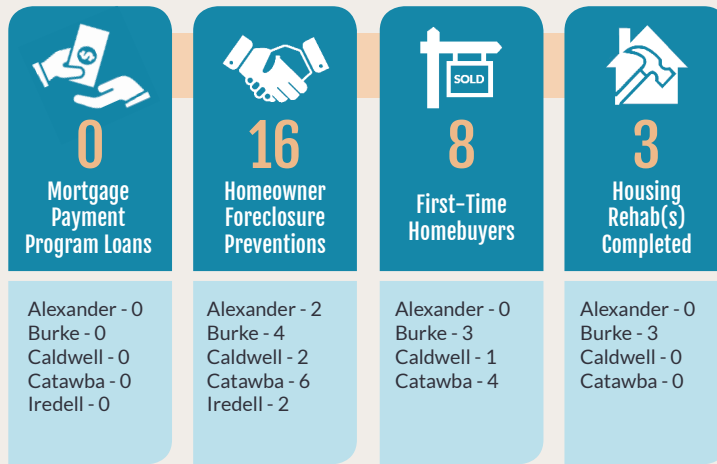

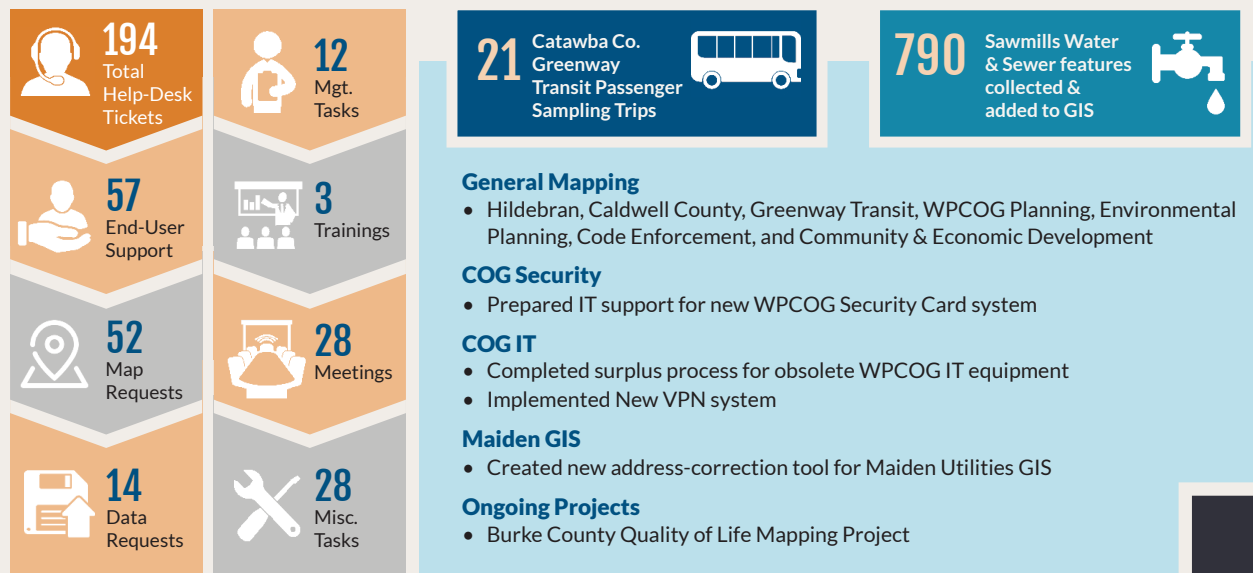


## GRANTS/ACTIVITIES
