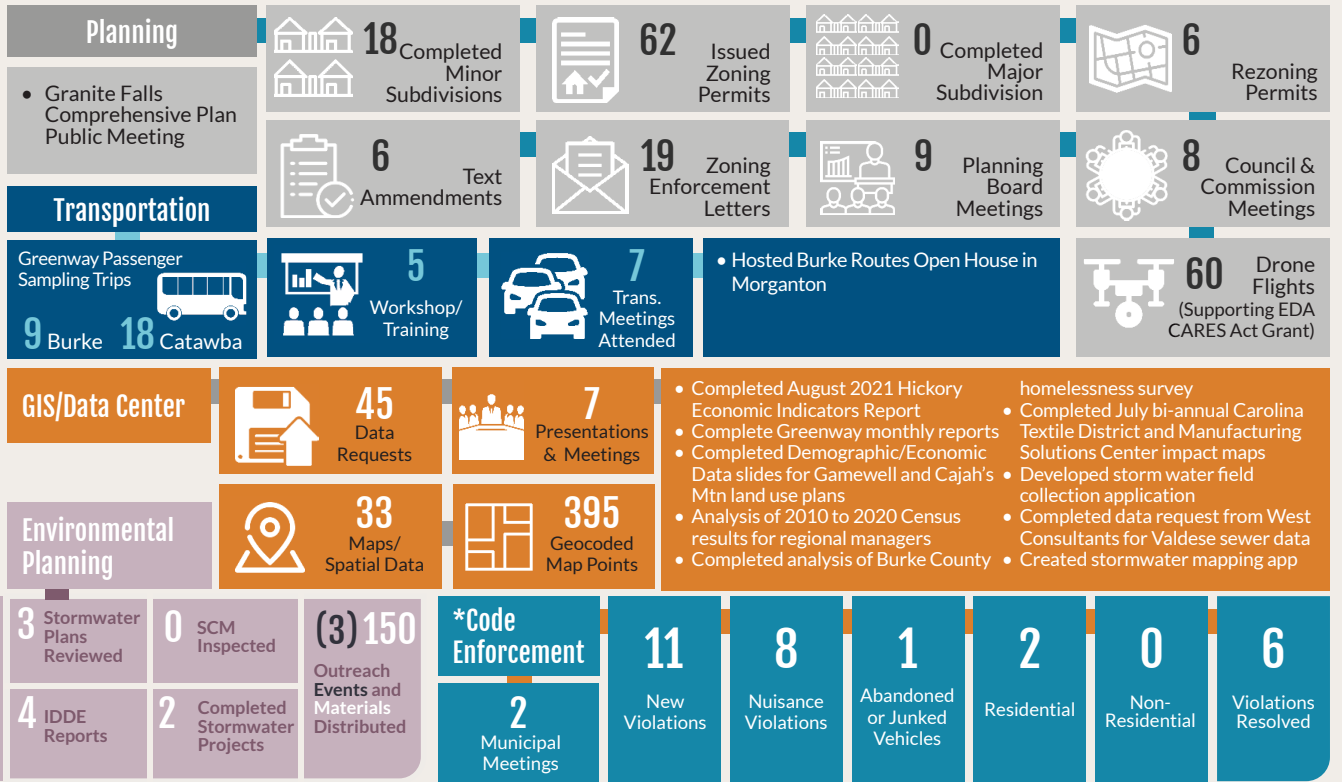

Grants and Activities

- Bid opening for 2 Burke ESFR houses, 2 Caldwell ESFR houses, 4 Caldwell URP houses and 3 Burke URP houses.
- CD Staff applied for three North Carolina Commerce Building Reuse Grants in August. Two of the projects are in City of Claremont, and the other one is in Town of Long View. The grant requests total \$959,000, and the companies will be creating a combined 145 new, full-time jobs. The grants are scheduled to be formally approved in October.

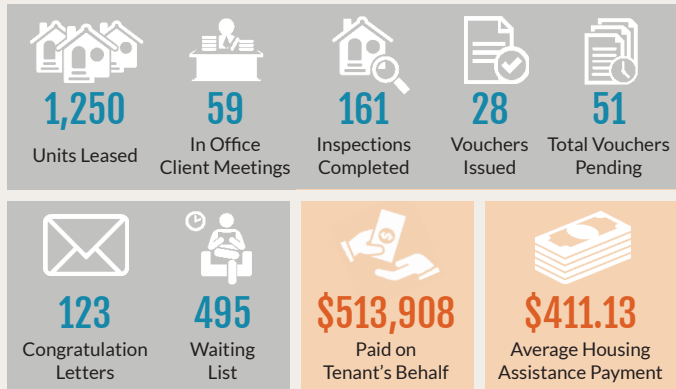

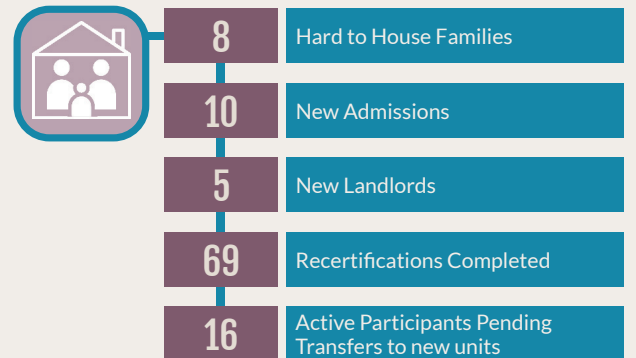

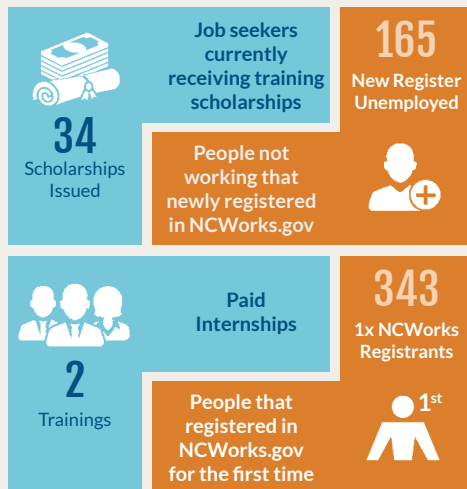
